

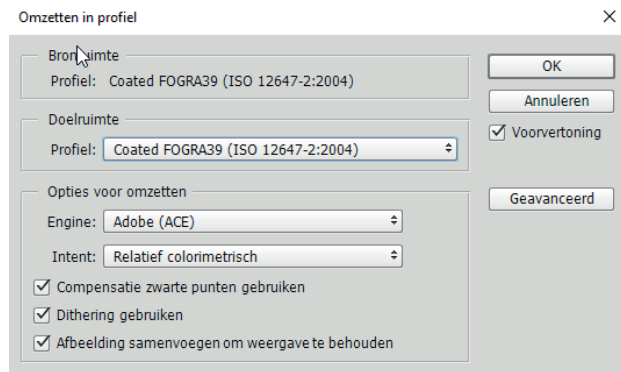
**Artwork is an important part of your project. To ensure the highest possible outcome of your design, please make sure only to use the supplied Orange Vinyl templates and keep the requirements below in mind.**

**Before creating any artwork, please consider the following:**

- Submit all artwork as Print-Ready "Flat PDF";
- Give your file the correct name: Catalog number + type of artwork (eg. OV001-Label-A of OV001-Outersleeve);
- Color Mode: CMYK (ICC COATED FOGRA39);
- Resolution: At least 300DPI/PPI;
- Bleed around: 5MM;
- Fill all cutouts on labels and sleeves with artwork or a color;
- Total Ink amount: Maximum 280%;
- Font size: At least 6P (especially when it concerns letters that are thin/lightly formatted).

Make sure all artwork fits in the correct templates and don't forget to add 5mm bleed all around. Flatten everything in terms of transparency and raster color gradients. Export as PDF standard 1.3 (1:1 so without scaling), settings for color export ICC Coated FOGRA39 as below:



Provide all artwork without visible template marks (no cut, fold or punch lines).

All fonts used must be made into objects (called 'create outline' in Illustrator and Indesign, 'convert to shape' in Photoshop).

Only in this way can we guarantee that your artwork will look great!

**These are the most common submission errors:**

- Artwork (or some parts) in RGB colors instead of CMYK;
- No bleed around the artwork;
- Artwork not formatted according to the correct template;
- Artwork is not the correct size.
